History: Sources of Information

I would like you to complete some research into sources of information. Sources of information help us learn about the past. There are both primary and secondary sources. I would like you to find out the difference between the two and then tell us about primary and secondary sources from the Titanic.

English: We are planning and writing an explanation text explaining why the Titanic sunk.

Please contact your teacher via Class Dojo so that they know to send you the relevant planning sheets.

We will be planning on Monday, writing our Introduction and Point 1 on Tuesday, Point 2 on Wednesday, Point 3 and the Conclusion on Thursday, and then planning an independent explanation text based on 'Why did so many people die on the Titanic' on Friday.

Art: Wallpaper Prints

This week, as artists, we are reviewing the styles of wallpapers that were in fashion during the construction of the Titanic and re-creating the patterns through careful, observational sketches.

Google 'wallpaper patterns 1910s' and copy up some images, paying careful attention to how they repeat. Which is your favourite and why?
