

## What 'Home Learning' can I expect from Burlington Junior School?

All of the children now have a Google Classroom log in and over the next two weeks they will be having homework set on there to complete. The children will be having training in school on how to use Google Classroom independently. In case of another **lockdown**, where the children have to work from home, all work will be posted on **Google Classroom**.

We aim to implement home learning from your child's second day of absence. There are 2 general scenarios outlined below; the first scenario where your child is not permitted to attend school and the second outlines the actions in the case of a whole bubble not being permitted to attend school. **If your child cannot access online learning either due to lack of an appropriate device or internet then please advise the school immediately so alternative work or device can be provided.**

<p>My child is absent because they are awaiting test results and our household is required to self-isolate. The rest of their school bubble are attending school and being taught as normal.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Register on Class Dojo at 9am by messaging class teacher.</li> <li>• An overview for the week will be uploaded on to Class Dojo and the school website. This will have the work to be completed and links attached to access learning and resources.</li> <li>• <b>Maths lessons</b> will be uploaded to Class Dojo, following on/mirroring the maths being covered in the classroom at that time. This may be a combination of Effective Maths (the scheme used in school), the screens shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets used in the classroom. Answers will be provided for self-marking at home.</li> <li>• <b>English tasks</b> will be uploaded to Class Dojo following the sequence of learning happening in the classroom where possible. The quantity will be dependent on age/stage of your child. Some/all of these will be 'handed in' to your child's class teacher on Google Classroom for marking and feedback.</li> <li>• <b>Curriculum:</b> these will follow the lessons being covered in class that week. Class learning, resources and worksheets from the lessons will be uploaded on to Google Classroom. If the lessons being taught in class are not able to be delivered remotely, then alternative 'theme' learning will be set on Google Classroom. These may make use of the Government's 'Oak Academy' lessons or 'BBC Bitesize'.</li> <li>• <b>Well-being and Online Safety:</b> learning and resources will be set each week on Class Dojo to support mental health, well-being and online safety.</li> <li>• <b>EHCP:</b> if your child receives 1:1 support on an EHCP and they are isolating, a more bespoke programme of support may be set up. The school SENCO will be available via Class Dojo.</li> </ul>
<p>My child's whole bubble is not permitted to attend school because they, or another member of their bubble, have tested positive for Covid-19.</p> <p>We enter another 'lockdown' with total school closure.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Register on Google Classroom at 9am by replying to your child's teachers post.</li> <li>• A detailed Learning Timetable for each day will be uploaded on to Google Classroom and the school website.</li> <li>• <b>Maths lessons</b> will be uploaded to Google Classroom, following on/mirroring the maths being covered in the classroom at that time. This may be a combination of Effective Maths (the scheme used in school), the screens shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets used in the classroom. Answers will be provided for self-marking at home. At least 2 lessons a week will have a pre-recorded teacher voice input from a teacher within their year group.</li> <li>• <b>English tasks</b> will be uploaded to Google Classroom and the website following the sequence of learning happening in the classroom. The quantity will be dependent on age/stage of your child. Some/all of these will be 'handed in' to your child's class teacher on Google Classroom for marking. This will include spelling, grammar, writing and reading. At least 2 lessons of reading and 2 lessons of writing a week will have a pre-recorded teacher voice input from a teacher within their year group.</li> <li>• <b>Curriculum:</b> will be uploaded to Google Classroom for children to complete and hand in virtually. This will be lessons your child would have had in class this term which can be most easily adapted to remote learning.</li> <li>• <b>EHCP:</b> if your child receives 1:1 support on an EHCP and they are isolating, a more bespoke programme of support may be set up. The school SENCO will discuss this in more detail.</li> <li>• <b>Well-being and Online Safety:</b> Learning and resources will be set each week on Class Dojo to support pupil's mental health, well-being and online safety.</li> <li>• <b>Question and Answer:</b> Monday to Thursday (3:15 to 3:30pm) there will be a question and</li> </ul>

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	<p>answers session for the children to ask their teacher questions about their learning on Google Classroom.</p>
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- **Peer to Peer interaction:** -Monday to Friday (12:30-1:30pm) there will be a discussion point posted for the children to talk to their peers about by posting on the year group stream.
- **Storytime:** Friday 3:15 to 3:30 will be story time where pupils can listen to a story read by their teacher or other story teller.
