


Year 3 Summer 2 Curriculum Overview

Subject: RE - Encounters

As theologians, we will explore the difference between special and sacred places. Using different sources and class discussions, we will explore some of the different ways that people use these spaces to communicate with their God.

As theologians, we will also study symbols and artefacts, as well as evaluating why each one is valued by believers and the religious communities.

Subject: Geography - Map Skills

As geographers, we will begin to research the equator and lines of latitude; we will then explore how these are linked to climate. Next, we will look at different climate zones, investigating the difference between the northern and southern hemispheres.

As geographers, we will also research temperate and tropical climates, as well as exploring weather patterns within a climate zone.

Subject: Science - Animals, Including Humans

As scientists, we will identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amounts of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.

As scientists, we will also explore the idea that animals, including humans, have skeletons and muscles. We will discuss and explore the functions of these, focusing on how they provide support and protection, whilst also facilitating movement.

Subject: PSHE - Changing Me

We will focus on how the body changes as we grow older, matching an infant body (animal and human) to the adult body. We will then discuss how the human body changes as we get older, especially during puberty; this will primarily focus on changes that occur outside the body. We will then discuss the changes that occur inside the body that are essential for us to grow. Finally, we will look at how a baby grows during pregnancy.
