**Host** – A country, city or organisation that provides for the facilities and other necessary things for an event. For the first time since 1998, the United Kingdom will play host to the Eurovision Song Contest.

**Influence** – The power to have an effect on someone or something. It can change how we feel, think, and even influence our actions.

**Participate** – To take part in something. Over 40 countries now often participate.

**Represent** – To speak, act, or be present officially on behalf of your country. Can you imagine how it might feel to be chosen to represent your country in a competition like this?
