This Week's Useful Vocabulary

Coronation – The ceremony at which a king or queen is crowned. The coronation of King Charles III is taking place at Westminster Abbey on Saturday 6th May.

Monarch – A king or queen. The coronation of a new monarch is a significant event and a key moment in history.

Rooted – Strongly influenced by or developed from something. Buckingham Palace has said that the coronation will be rooted in long-standing traditions.
