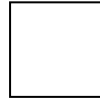

Should lifejackets be compulsory for all on open water?



In the news this week

In Canada, the government in the province of Ontario is set to pass a new law that will make it compulsory for children aged 12 and under to wear lifejackets on boats. Parents, guardians, or other adults supervising children could be subject to a fine of up to \$200 (£130) if they do not comply. In the UK, currently, there is no legal requirement for anyone using rivers and seas for leisure purposes to wear a lifejacket/personal flotation device (PFD).

Things to talk about at home ...

- Share your experience of lifejackets. Have you ever been required to wear one? Where were you? Did everyone wear them?
- Can you make a list of all the times you think lifejackets should be worn?
- Do you feel there should be laws in place to ensure people wear lifejackets on boats at sea? If so, do you believe they should apply to everyone?

This weeks useful vocabulary

Comply – To follow or obey a set of rules, an order or request. Parents, guardians, or other adults supervising children could be subject to a fine of up to \$200 (£130) if they do not comply.

Compulsory – Required by law or a rule that must be followed. The Water Safety (Curriculum) Bill requires water safety and training as a compulsory part of the curriculum for all schools in England.

Mandatory – Required by law or an official order. Several states have mandatory wear regulations.

Province – One of the areas that a country is divided into, which often has some control over its own laws. In Canada, the government in the province of Ontario is set to pass a new law that will make it compulsory for children aged 12 and under to wear lifejackets on boats.

Unpredictable – Likely to change suddenly and without reason. Time spent on water can be unpredictable and dangerous.

Vessel – A large boat or ship. The laws on wearing a lifejacket when on board a boat or vessel at sea vary around the world.
