The children had a fantastic morning at Headlands School for their super performing arts day. The theme throughout the day were the 4 elements: Earth, Wind, Fire and Water.


The children got to explore the art, music, and performing art departments throughout the morning and did a range of activities from dancing, singing and playing musical instruments.

In the news this week

The 2024 edition of the Guinness World Records has been released. This year, over 30,000 applicants submitted their achievements, but only 2,638 records were selected for the edition, which features more than 80% new and updated records. The annual collection of records has run since 1955, when it was first inspired by the question 'What's the fastest game bird in Europe?'. Its latest edition is themed around the Blue Planet. with a number of records celebrated, including those set by impressive marine creatures, adventurous sailors and recordbreaking lakes, rivers and icescapes.

Edition – A particular version of a book, magazine, or newspaper that is printed at one time. The 2024 edition of the Guinness World Record has been released.

Fulfil – Do what is required, necessary or expected to complete something. All Guinness World Records titles must fulfil key criteria.

Published – To prepare and issue something such as a book for public sale or distribution.

The Guinness Book of World Records is a reference book published annually.

Submitted – Giving or offering something for a decision to be made by others. This year, over 30,000 applicants submitted their achievements.

Themed – Designed to relate to a particular subject, place or time. Its latest edition is themed around the Blue Planet.



















On Tuesday 10th October, Year 3 and 4 will require their PE kit to participate in a year group cross country competition which is held by the school sports partnership.
