# This weeks useful vocabulary

**Emoji –** A small digital image or icon used to represent or express an idea or emotion. Share your own experience of emojis.

**Express** – Show what you think or feel. Emojis can be a good way to express online how we are feeling.

**Impression –** An idea or opinion of what something or someone is like. He says it gives the wrong impression of glasses-wearers.

**Offensive** – Causing someone to feel resentful, upset or annoyed. 'If I find it offensive there'll be thousands of people around the world that fund it offensive too.'



**Petition** – A document signed by a large number of people asking for some action from the government or another authority.

**Representation –** The way that someone or something is shown or described. Teddy Cottle first noticed the glasses emoji when texting his cousin, and felt it wasn't a fair representation of glasses wearers.

# **Times Table Challenge!**

This half term, we are going to focus on times tables across school. Times tables are essential when learning many new Mathematical skills and concepts from the National Curriculum, such as fractions, decimals and factors etc.

The goal is instant recall, and to encourage children to achieve this by the end of Year 4, there is now a Year 4 MTC (The Multiplication Tables Check) that schools administer to keep track of how children are getting on.

As a school, we are setting the children, 'The Burlington Times Table Trial'. The children are given five minutes to answer as many questions as they can. There are three different stages. As children complete each stage, they will automatically move on. We will complete the trial in the first week back and then again at the end of the term to see how much progress has been made. We will present certificates and prizes at the end of the half term.

We would like you to support your child as much as possible. Each child has a TTRS (Time Table Rock Stars) account that they can access at home. In school, we will provide support also.

I know the children love a challenge so we look forward to seeing the progress made during this half term. Good luck everyone!



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
