**Autonomous –** Able to operate without being controlled directly by humans. The government introduced a bill in a speech by King Charles III that paved the way for autonomous cars.

**Navigation –** The act of knowing your position and planning and following a route. Using this information, the car then identifies an appropriate navigation path and strategies for managing traffic controls.

**Optical** – Relating to vision or light. Self-driving cars use sensors to identify their surroundings, such as optical and heat cameras, radar, GPS, and other technologies.

**Revolutionise** – To drastically change something for the better. Self-driving transport has the power to revolutionise how we travel.
