The staff were then challenged to complete tasks in teams: one challenge was to work out how to make a free-standing flagpole without any digging into the ground; another was to find out all we could about a tree; a further task was to make a map of the UK from a rope and identify where all the capital cities were. It was a very enjoyable morning for all of the staff, as it will also be for our pupils.
