Subject areas covered: Art, Science and RE

As artists, we will be looking at Hokusai's work on the '36 Views of Mt Fuji', focusing on 'The Great Wave Off Kanagawa'. We will analyse the original work before recreating our own version using watercolours and other mixed medias.

As theologians we will be exploring our world and the different creation stories, including the scientific explanation for the world's creation and religious creation stories.



Theme: Animals Including Humans

Subject areas covered: Science and Computing.
