Children and young people travel to Sheffield from all over the country, and even the world, for ground-breaking medical treatment. This makes the hospital one of the nation's best for paediatric care, and home to some of the UK's leading clinicians. Sheffield Children's even had patients from the **United States, India and Egypt** in 2022/23.

How much do you know about Sheffield Children's?

Mental Health Support Teams currently work with **50 schools** in and around Sheffield to provide children and young people with early intervention and preventative mental health support.

Patients travel as far as **100 miles** to Sheffield Children's Sleep Team for specialist treatment.

Sheffield Children's respite centre, Ryegate House, had **895 overnight stays** in 2022/23, to help families of children with neurodevelopmental conditions.

341 active research studies are run in the Clinical Research Facility, with sponsors from across Europe and as far as USA.

10,214 inpatients were admitted to one of the wards at Sheffield Children's, staying for a total of **42,483 nights**.

More than **65,000 patients** were seen in the Emergency Department in 2022/23.

The transport service, Embrace, completed **1,908 patient transfers** across Yorkshire and the Humber and beyond.

Ophthalmology's paediatric contact lens service has been working for **21 years** with babies and children who've had cataracts removed.

Lunch balance

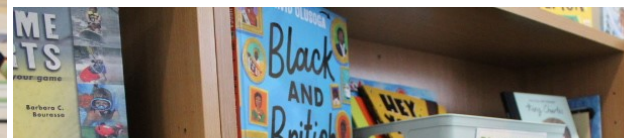
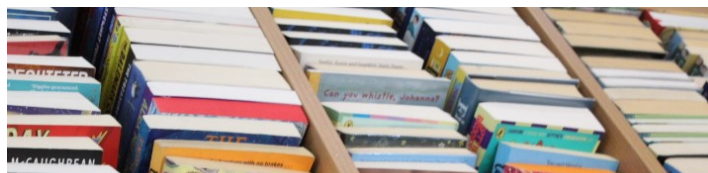
