Astronaut – A person who has been trained to travel in space. Space agency, Nasa, says two astronauts stuck on the International Space Station (ISS) won't return to Earth until next year.

Deemed - To consider or judge something in a particular way. It was deemed unsafe for them to return on the craft

Encountered - To experience something, often something unpleasant. Sunita and Barry journeyed into space in early June on a spacecraft called the Starliner, but the spacecraft encountered problems on its way out.

Essential - Extremely important or necessary. They will join in with the upcoming SpaceX Crew-9 mission, taking on essential duties such as conducting spacewalks, and participating in scientific experiments. **Mission -** An important job or task. Space capsule – A spacecraft, or a part of a spacecraft, that contains people or equipment. The Boeing Starliner spacecraft has a problem, so they need to wait for a different space capsule to bring them home in February.
