In the news this week

E-commerce company, Amazon, has told all staff they need to return to the office five days a week next year, ending the option to work from home. In a message to all workers, Chief Executive Andy Jassy said the company expected everyone to be in the office full time (apart from some exceptions) from 2nd January, 2025. Amazon's new policy is very different from the UK government's approach, which is to make flexible working a right for employees, as promised in a new law proposal, due to be announced later this year.

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Attend - Go to or be present at a place or event. Can you think of any jobs that need people to attend the place of work?

Flexible - Being able to adjust to new changes or situations. Flexible working is an arrangement allowing people to choose when and where they complete their work.

Leisure - Free time to do the things you enjoy, like reading, playing or watching TV. Spending time and interacting with others is an important part of life, both when we are working and in our leisure time.

Policy - A set of rules or guidelines that a company or person can use to help make decisions and take actions. Amazon's new policy is very different from the UK government's approach.

Proposal - Ideas or plans that someone suggests to others for approval or agreement to move forward with a project, event, or action. The UK government's approach is to make flexible working a right for employees, as promised in a new law proposal due to be announced later this year.

Remotely - Doing something from a distance or a different location, often using computers or phones to stay connected. They may wish to work in the office or somewhere remotely, such as at home.
